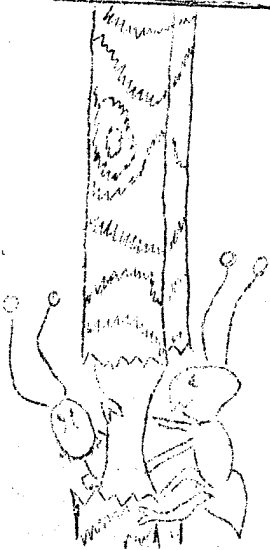

Steeds het sy hulp gelewer met wat maar ook in die skool se belange geraak het. Ook nog na haar aftrede het sy herhaaldelik die skool kom help.

Haar diepe nederigheid, haar toewyding en liefde, die stille krag wat van haar uitgegaan het - ons het dit ervaar. Ons waardeer haar daarvoor en vir haar opregtheid, getrouheid en vriendskap.

THE DEBATING SOCIETY

There was a committee of six: Marius Mostert, Roger Gladwell, André Bester, Suzette Kemp, Carol le Grange, Alwyn Geldenhuys. Our first topic was: "Is the youth of South Africa degenerating?" Those who supported the motion were André Bester, Suzette Kemp and Beatrix Janse van Rensburg, and those who opposed the meeting were Wynand Loubser, Trevor Sykes and Carol le Grange. A Speech contest was also held and this proved most popular.

This year André Bester was elected as Chairman and Carol le Grange as Secretary. The Committee members are Suzette Kemp, Wynand Loubser, Alwyn Geldenhuys, Denise Buckley, Mary Allan, Sandra Booysens.

The debate that was held on Friday, the 23rd of March, 1973 was well-attended and proved very successful. The topic was "Is it a waste of time and money for a girl to study further after the Matriculation Examination?" Those who supported the motion were Sandra Booysens, Hilda Milward and Muriel Crous, and those who opposed the motion were Monica Jonker, René Bester and Maeva Gladwell. A short concert was held after the Debate and tea and cake were served.

One of the highlights of 1972 was our visit to the R.S.A., the stout little research ship. The keel of the ship was laid down in the ship-building yards of Osaka on 4th April, 1961 and when construction was completed the R.S.A. was accepted and signed for on 30th November 1961. The small ice-breaker has given her country sterling service, sailing through

heaving oceans menaced by deadly ice-bergs, taking men South to build research stations at Sanae on the continental ice-shelf. Captain McNish lectured to pupils of the school and illustrated the points he made by means of slides which showed the brilliant colours of Antarctica. Another highlight was a visit to Milnerton High School to see a new version of "Macbeth" called "The Butcher's Bad Dream." It was a modern version and the pupils sat in petrified silence as they followed the mental agony experienced by Macbeth.

1972 was a very successful year for the S.C.A. We studied the parables that Jesus told and we had plays acted by various classes. We had come combined meetings with the

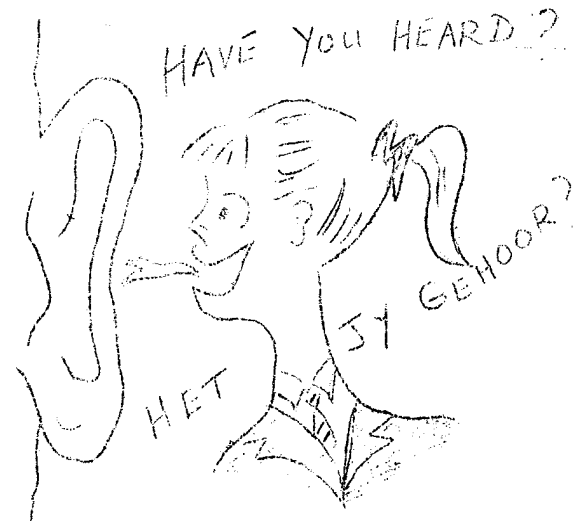
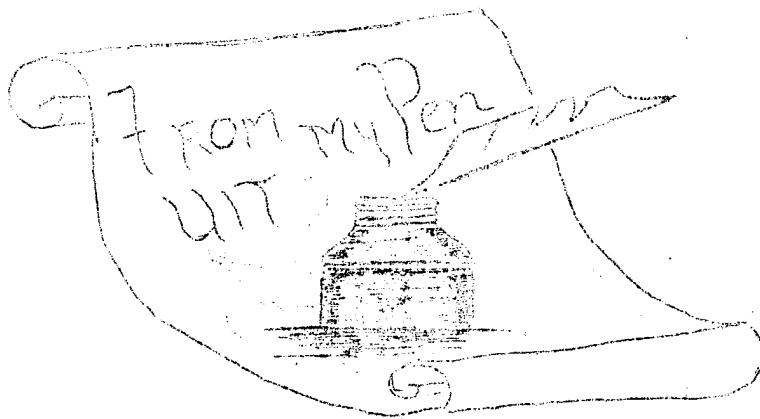

I need, and have accepted the loss of my wife, and am, therefore, a happy man. Every evening after dinner, I take Coo-Tup, my Basset hound, for a walk.

It was two months ago that my nightmare began. Until my neighbours, Terence and Joy Oldham, moved in next door to us a year ago, I had never seen a boy as lively, happy and jolly as their son, Ricki. He was a typical boy, Mischievous! My fruit trees were never safe. All the same, I liked that family. One evening, upon returning from my stroll, I saw Ricki playing in the street. Jock Adams, who lives across the street, is always in a hurry. I saw him drive up to his front gate, leap out of his car, and run inside. He's car started rolling backwards. Ricki did not see the car coming towards him. I yelled to him, but my voice was drowned by the sound of lorry roaring past. I ran towards Ricki and tried to grab him. I tripped and fell against him. His head hit the pavement, and, with horror, I saw his skull crack open like a nut. Blood spurted from his head and drenched his clothes as well as mine. I did not have to look at him to see that he was dead. I fainted.

I gripped the cold, iron, hand-rail of the dock. Cold sweat beaded the nape of my neck as I waited for the judge's verdict. Although my lawyer had fought a brilliant battle, and I had pleaded not guilty, I was certain I would not escape. My head throbbed. I heard the judge's monotone, "I hereby sentence George Arthur Burkes to thirty years' hard labour, guilty of", and for the first time since Julie's death, I broke down.

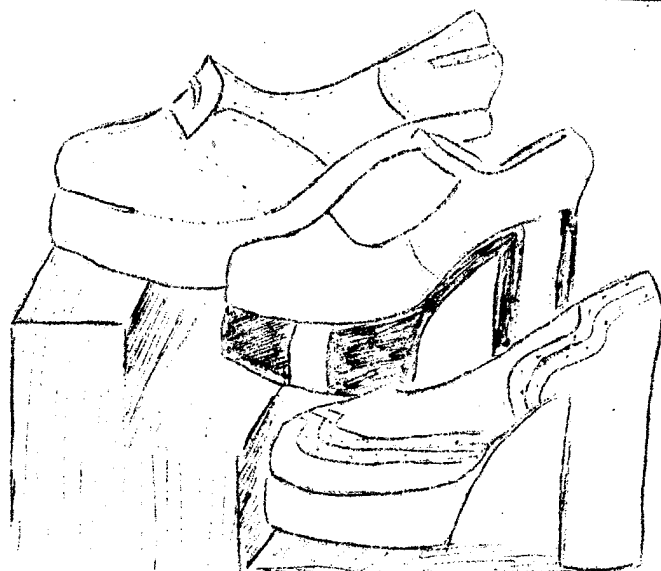

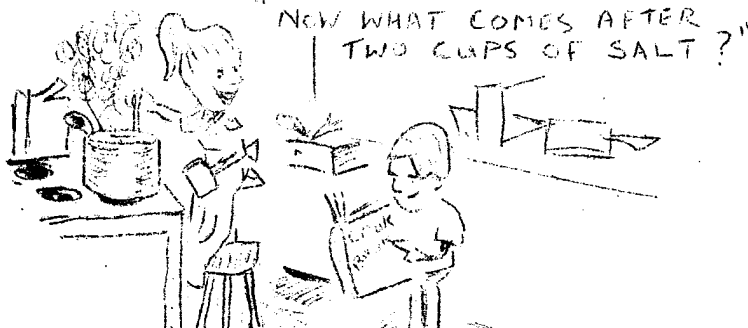

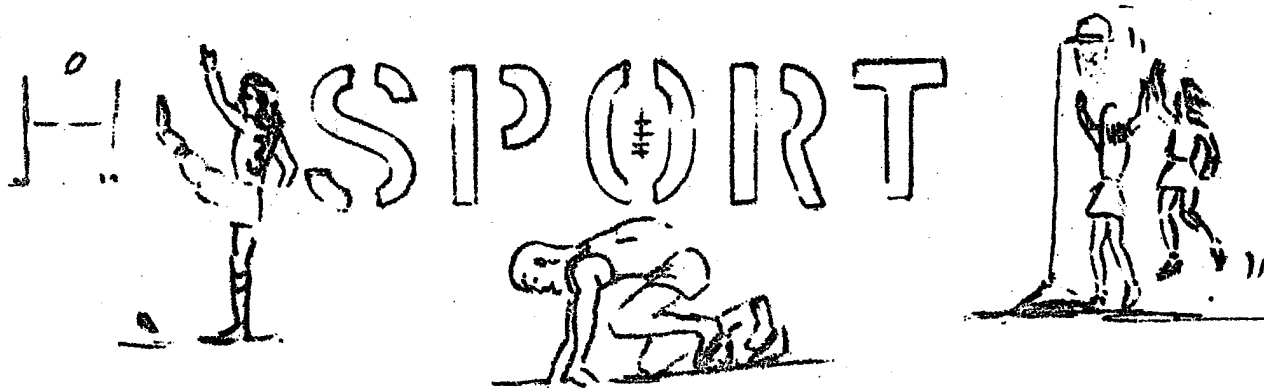

W.P. Schools Meeting

By die W.P. skiereiland kampioenskappe wat op 3 Maart te Groenpunt gehou is het ons atlete puik vertoon.

Gertjie Hartman won the U.17 long jump titel and Miemie Wolmarans the U.16 discus. Gert Vorster managed a second place in the long jump U.19.

Hierdie drie atlete is toe ook opgeneem in die W.P. skiereilandspan wat in die Paarl gaan deelneem het. Hier het slegs Gert Vorster nog 'n tweede plek kon behaal, maar nogtans geluk met die prestasie julle drie ons is trots op julle.

Neville Swart, 2nd in the U.14 long jump; Karin du Toit, 2nd U.13 100 m and Wynand Loubser and Brian Fish, who qualified for the U.19 sprints, were the other of our athletes to do well in Green Point but the climax of the day was right at the last event of the day.
